Over the past year the Solihull Arden Club has demonstrated exceptional commitment to the inclusivity, community engagement, and transformative power of sport. We've collaborated with various organizations and taken innovative steps to make a meaningful difference in lives of diverse groups.

In partnership with Birmingham and Solihull NHS Mental Health Trust we supported Young Adults in Mental Health Recovery and adapted sports sessions for young adults in early stages of psychosis, these sessions provided a safe and engaging space to help participants rebuild confidence and reintegrate into society.

We worked with the NHS in their 'Empowering Women through Social Sports' program, these sessions encouraged interaction, low-impact exercises and support for Women facing mental health challenges.

The Solihull Arden Club is really proud to work alongside local disability groups within the Solihull Borough, we opened up our facilities on a weekly basis throughout the year with engaging Tennis and Fitness based sessions that are truly changing lives.

We partnered with the Ukrainian refugee charity BRAMA to deliver community tennis sessions for children and adults on Sunday afternoons on the tarmac courts at the bottom of the club with over 150 participants engaging in this supportive community project.

Finally, our very own club success and membership growth was a huge factor in winning the Award, this growth enabled the club to spend over £115k this year on outdoor projects which included new LED lights and padel court resurfacing. Despite these huge costs the Solihull Arden club still managed to change its policy on tennis court lights and made all court lighting totally free!

We would like to take the opportunity to thank Alex Thompson, Ian Poole and their team for all of the outstanding community and club projects they deliver at the Solihull Arden Club throughout the year.

Finally, a big thank you to all of the members on recently formed Tennis Committee who worked extremely hard to get the application over the line.
